FAQ

We are so excited that you are interested in finding out about Performance Team!
Here are answers to some of the most frequently asked questions.

AUDITION PROCESS

Auditions are held in May for students 5 years of age and older. During the audition you will learn a short combination and then perform it in front of our panel of teachers.

INVITATION TO PERFORMANCE TEAM

If you have been accepted to Performance Team, you will receive a letter in early June.

The letter will include a list of dances you have been invited to and a rehearsal schedule. All Team Members participate in our Production routine and dancers may also be invited to other dances. Dancers are invited to dances based on age and experience.

The letter also explains the fees for the dances you have been invited to and includes a Team contract. You will be asked to return your signed Team contract and pay all fees prior to the first rehearsal.

REHEARSALS

Our Performance Team dances rehearse during late June and the entire month of July on Tuesdays and from September through February on Saturdays. The attendance policy is outlined in the invitation letter, but in general you are allowed 2 absences.

FEES

Each dance you are performing requires a \$190 choreography fee, a \$90 costume fee, and various fees for competition entries.

COMPETITIONS

Our Performance Team attends 4 competitions each year. They are typically held in November, January, February, and March. Exact dates are communicated in the invitation letter.

Competitions run over the weekend and can be as little as half a day or as long as Friday afternoon through Sunday night. Dances are scheduled by the competitions and can sometimes be held very early in the morning or well past bedtime.

Two of our competitions are held at hotels (where you are welcome to stay over) and two are held at schools.

COMMUNITY EVENTS

Our Performance Team members are also encouraged to perform at Community Events throughout the year. Signups happen a few weeks prior to the event and we decide on the dances being performed based on who can be there.
